Sponsored by the ABA Antitrust Law Section, the Janet D. Steiger Fellowship Project provides rising 2L and 3L law students with an extraordinary opportunity to spend the summer of 2022 working in one of 40 consumer protection departments of state and territorial Offices of Attorneys General and other consumer protection agencies across the country. Fellows receive a \$6,000 stipend, subject to certain taxes and administered through the participating agencies. The Fellowship is named in memory of Janet Steiger, the first woman to chair the Federal Trade Commission and a steadfast advocate for cooperative state-federal consumer protection enforcement.
